WHAT IS A COOKIE?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit, or to another website that recognises that cookie.

Cookies do lots of different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, and generally improving the user experience.

WHAT ARE 'SESSION' AND 'PERSISTENT' COOKIES?

Cookies that expire at the end of a browser session (normally when a user exits their browser) are called 'session cookies'. Cookies that can be stored for longer are called 'persistent cookies'.

- Session cookies allow websites to recognise and link the actions of a user during a browsing session. They may
 be used for a variety of purposes such as remembering what a user has put in their shopping basket as they
 browse around a site. Cookies can also be used for security purposes, such as when a user logs in to internet
 banking or their webmail. These session cookies expire after a session ends, so would not be stored beyond this.
- Persistent cookies are stored on a user's device in-between sessions. They can allow the preferences or actions
 of the user across a site (or across different websites) to be remembered. Persistent cookies may be used for a
 variety of purposes including remembering users' preferences and choices when using a site or to target
 advertising.

WHAT ARE 'FIRST-PARTY' AND 'THIRD-PARTY' COOKIES?

- First-party cookies are set directly by us.
- **Third-party cookies** are set by a domain other than the one you are visiting. This typically occurs when a website incorporates elements from other sites, such as images, social media plugins or advertising.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES ARE THERE ON THIS WEBSITE?

- **Strictly necessary cookies (aka essential cookies)**. These cookies are essential, e.g., to enable a website to be browsed. These cookies will generally be first-party session cookies.
- Statistics cookies (aka analytics and performance cookies). These cookies collect information e.g., which pages on a website are visited and which links are clicked on.

Using cookies, web beacons, pixels and/or SDKs helps us to better understand which content is of interest to our website visitors, subscribers to our newsletters etc.
